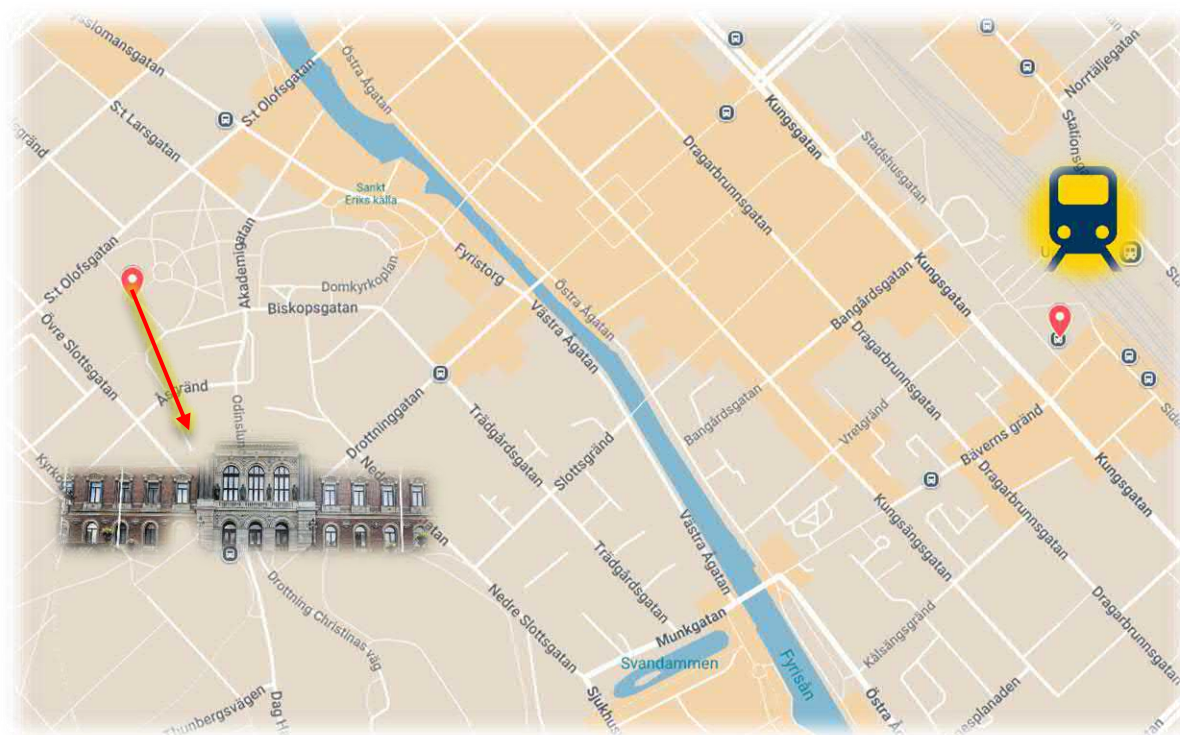
Welcome

We look forward to welcoming you to Uppsala for *Climate Impacts in a Changing World 2026*. This information pack provides practical guidance to help you prepare for your arrival and participation.

1. Arrival & Getting to the Venue

Venue Location

University Main Building (Universitetshuset)
Biskopsgatan 3, 753 10 Uppsala



From Stockholm Arlanda Airport

- Regional and commuter trains connect Arlanda Airport and Uppsala (approx. 20 minutes). You can buy tickets for most of these trains directly at the airport station "Arlanda centralstation". Do not take the Arlanda Express train, as it only goes to Stockholm and does not serve Uppsala.
- Bus line 801 also operates between Arlanda and Uppsala (approx. 40 minutes).

By Train

- Travel to Uppsala Central Station. Most long-distance trains terminate in Stockholm. From Stockholm central station there are frequent services to Uppsala (~3-4 an hour during daytime). The travel time is ~40 minutes.
- The venue is approximately a 15-minute walk from the station.
- For travel by public transport (bus) from the station to the conference venue, see below.
- Taxis are available outside the station.

Travel inside Uppsala by Bus (UL Public Transport)

Nearby bus stops:

- Slottsbacken
(approx. 2 minutes walk)
- Saluhallen
(approx. 5 minutes walk)

Suggested routes include buses 1, 2, 6, 7, 9 and 11.

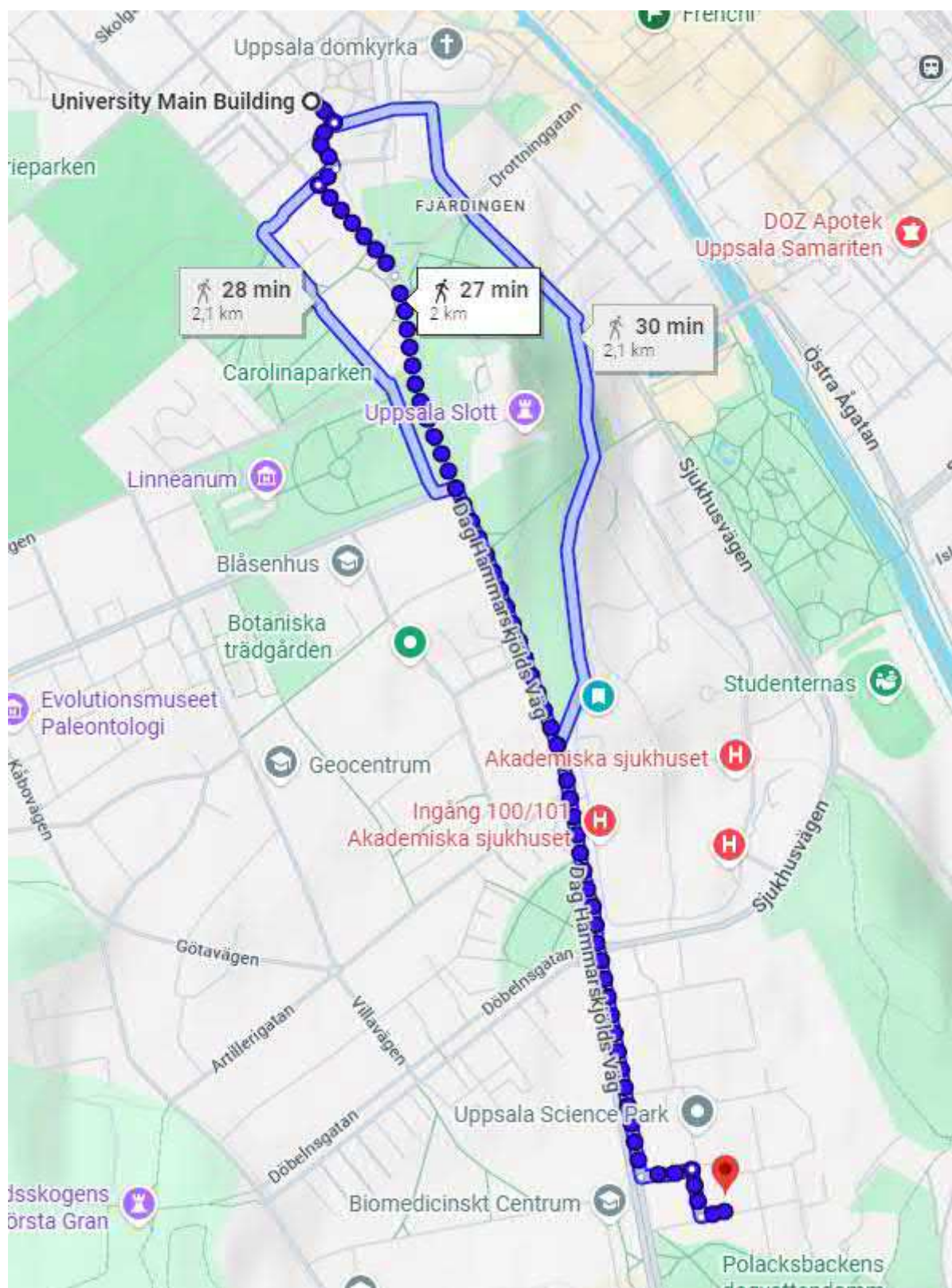

Wi-Fi

Available networks:

eduroam – Use your institutional credentials.

UU-Guest – Create a temporary account using your mobile phone number. Login details are sent via SMS.

Uppsala Guest – Municipality public Wi-Fi in central Uppsala (SMS registration required).

Accessibility

University Main Building provides elevator access to all session floors.

An accessible entrance is located at the rear of the building (via Övre Slottsgatan) with automatic door access and step-free entry.

Cloakroom

Cloakrooms are available within the building and will be clearly signposted. Storage is unattended, and conference organisers take no responsibility for the personal belongings of the attendees.

Poster Presenters

- Board dimensions: 137 × 96 cm
- Maximum size: A0 (portrait orientation only)
- Posters must be printed in advance. The conference organisers do not offer any printing service.
- Mounting via provided pins only (no tape, glue, Velcro, clips, etc.)

Poster sessions:

All posters will be displayed during both poster sessions.

- Day 1: 15:45–17:00
- Day 2: 10:45–12:00

Oral Presenters

- Total slot: 17 minutes, including discussion
- Presentation time: recommended 13 minutes, maximum 15 minutes
- Strict adherence to timing is required

Technical setup:

- You may use your own computer
- HDMI cables and hubs are available
- Bring your own adapter if needed
